**THE BOROUGH OF BRENTWOOD (ON STREET PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER NO. ...**  
**THE BOROUGH OF BRENTWOOD (ON STREET PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS (AMENDMENT) ORDER NO. .../200..**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Brentwood Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made with the Essex County Council and following consultation with the Chief Officer of Police proposes to make an Order in exercise of its powers contained under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2), 32 and 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will be incorporated and consolidated into the Borough of Brentwood (On-Street Parking and Waiting Restrictions) Order.

The approximate measurements of the restrictions are shown below:

**High Street, Brentwood**

**Proposed - No waiting, loading or unloading at any time**

**North side**

From its junction with Ongar Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 36 metres.  
From a point 111 metres west of its junction with Ongar Road to a point 113 metres east of its junction with Weald Road.

From its junction with Weald Road in an easterly direction for distance of 77 metres.  
From a point 92 metres east of its junction with Weald Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 8 metres.

**South side**

From its junction with Ingrave Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 29 metres.

From a point 14 metres west of its junction with St Thomas Road to a point 36 metres east of its junction with St Thomas Road.

From a point 62 metres west of its junction with St Thomas Road to a point 56 metres east of its junction with Crown Street.

From a point 26 metres east of its junction with Crown Street to a point 62 metres west of its junction with Crown Street.

From its junction Kings Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 95 metres.

**High Street, Brentwood**

**Proposed - No waiting at any time**

**North side**

From a point 77 metres east of its junction with Weald Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

**South side**

From a point 26 metres east of its junction with Crown Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 32 metres.



**High Street, Brentwood**

**Proposed - No stopping at any time except for buses**

**Both sides**

From a point 100 metres east of its junction with Weald Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 13 metres.

**North side**

From a point 36 metres west of its junction with Ongar Road in a westerly direction for distance of 75 metres.

**South side**

From a point 29 metres west of its junction with Ingrave Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 75 metres.

**High Street, Brentwood**

**Proposed - No waiting at any time except for Motorcycles**

**South side**

From a point 8 metres west of its junction with St Thomas Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.

**High Street, Brentwood**

**Proposed - No waiting at any time except for blue badge holders**

**South side**

From a point 14 metres west of its junction with St Thomas Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 48 metres.

A copy of the draft Order, a plan showing the proposals of the roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order are available at the Town Hall, Ingrave Road, Brentwood, CM15 8AY and The Information Centre, 44 High Street, Brentwood, CM14 4AJ where they may be inspected during normal office hours.
