### **Brentwood High Street – Improvement Works**

As part of the ongoing construction works the following programmed works will be in progress during the w/c 05 October to w/e 31 October 2009: -

#### **Phase 9 South side**

**Ch. 560 – 660 (Iceland to Old Post office and junction with St Thomas Road).**

- Paving works to completion by w/e 02 October.

**Ch. 780 - 810, (Next to Rossi).**

- Block work to bus lay by.

Various operations will be on-going along the whole length of High Street IN THE CARRIAGEWAY, so for safety, pedestrians will be restricted to the footways. 5 crossing points will be available, as indicated below, but extra attention will be given when machinery is operating nearby.

#### **EDF Works – High Street from**

- High Street, north side, south of Weald Road, from 151a High Street passed Tower Street, Sovereign House and Stone Gallery, to just south of the junction with Westbury Road. Single lane working under traffic control to install ducts and cables.

### **HIGH STREET CLOSED TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FOR 25 DAYS FROM 6.00 a.m. MONDAY 5<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER**

From Monday 5 October, it will be necessary to restrict pedestrian movement to the footways, erecting barriers for the full length of High Street, for safety reasons, but providing five (5) crossing points along the length of High Street, in the general vicinity of the final locations of the future permanent signal controlled crossing points: -

**Wilson's Corner from Clement Joscelyne to Nationwide B.S.  
Thos. Cook to Specsavers  
KRISP to Nat West Bank  
McDonalds to Slug and Lettuce  
Mr Savile to Peking Chef (Weald Road/Kings Road junction).**

These locations may need to vary slightly as work progresses. Part of the remaining work involves resurfacing the carriageway, after the existing has been planed off. Initially this will introduce varying differences in level between the new footway and the adjacent roadway. At the selected crossing points these differences in level will be eliminated by ramps where they are in use. Weather conditions will play an important aspect during the 25 days of the closure, which can affect the rate of progress and the precise location of the crossing points.

Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate pedestrian needs during this difficult period.

Alternative arrangements for vehicular movement, especially for deliveries has been agreed prior to the closure period, and a circular has been issued to all concerned giving details of how this will need to operate and the necessary contact details.
