Brentwood High Street – Improvement Works

As part of the ongoing construction works the following programmed works will be in progress during the w/c 28 September to w/e 11 October 2009: -

Phase 9 South side

Ch. 560 – 660 (Iceland to Old Post office).

- Kerbing works to be completed by w/e 02 October.
- Paving works to completion by w/e 02 October.
- New lamp columns to be erected outside Iceland and Starbucks.

Phase 12 North side

Ch. 680 - 750, (Public Toilets to Halfords).

- Block paving to bus lay bys, continuing to completion by w/e 02 October.
- Installation of pedestrian signal control equipment opposite Clement Joscelyne to w/e 2 October.

Ch. 780 - 810, (Pizza Express to Wilson's Corner).

- Paving works to footway, continuing to completion by w/e 02 October.

Weald Road Eastern side

- Eastern footway construction alongside The Gallery, excavation 26 September and paving works 28 September. Temporary restriction of traffic to a single lane approaching the traffic lights and diverting pedestrians into a temporary footway in the carriageway.

Snagging works

- Minor snagging works to various areas of paving will be carried out during the period.

EDF Works

- Install ducting north side in carriageway on Sundays 27 September and 04 October, 10.00 to 18.30.
- Excavation for new HV connections from link box adjacent to Opticians.
- Cabling operations Swan to Opticians.
- EDF connections to properties North side, Waterstones and Dorothy Perkins.
- Jointing properties Swan to Opticians completed by w/e 02 October

Additional EDF Works during the week commencing 28 September.

- Kings Road, east side, south for 25 m, in footway, and across j/w Hart Road - linking to ducts laid in Phase 1 of the scheme. Traffic in Kings Road north bound will be confined to one lane for a short section leading up to the traffic lights at the junction with High Street, to allow traffic displaced southbound for pedestrians to be accommodated in the carriageway.
- High Street, north side footway, south of Weald Road, from 151a High Street passed Tower Street, Sovereign House and Stone Gallery, to just south of the junction with Westbury Road. Single lane working under traffic control, during off peak periods, 09.30 to 16.30.

**HIGH STREET CLOSED TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FOR 25 DAYS FROM
6.00 a.m. MONDAY 5TH OCTOBER**

From Monday 5 October, it will be necessary to restrict pedestrian movement to the footways, erecting barriers for the full length of High Street, for safety reasons, but providing five (5) crossing points along the length of High Street, in the general vicinity of the final locations of the future permanent signal controlled crossing points: -

**Wilson's Corner from Clement Joscelyne to Nationwide B.S.
Thos. Cook to Specsavers
KRISP to Nat West Bank
McDonalds to Slug and Lettuce
Mr Savile to Peking Chef (Weald Road/Kings Road junction).**

These locations may need to vary slightly as work progresses. Part of the remaining work involves resurfacing the carriageway, after the existing has been planed off. Initially this will introduce varying differences in level between the new footway and the adjacent roadway. At the selected crossing points these differences in level will be eliminated by ramps where they are in use. Weather conditions will play an important aspect during the 25 days of the closure, which can affect the rate of progress and the precise location of the crossing points. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate pedestrian needs during this difficult period.

Alternative arrangements for vehicular movement, especially for deliveries has to be agreed prior to the closure period, and a circular has been issued to all concerned giving details of how this will need to operate and the necessary contact details.

Where paving works are being carried out it is necessary to complete works to individual shop accesses outside trading hours. Heavy excavation works are undertaken early to complete by 20.00. Paving works are carried out to completion to ensure safe admittance to shoppers the next day.
